Dear Parents/Carers,

Topic visit to Stoke Bruerne – Tuesday 22nd May

Year 3 are visiting Stoke Bruerne as part of their topic work on 'Our Wonderful World of Water'. During the day the children will participate in three activities: a session in the Stoke Bruerne Museum, explaining the history of the canal; a walk to learn how the canal works and a boat ride to appreciate the use of water for leisure activities and its significance in the tourism industry.

The visit will take place during the school day so the children need to be dropped off and collected as usual. **The coach will leave at 9am.** They will need to wear school uniform, suitable shoes and have a coat that is suitable for the weather conditions on the day. They should also take sun cream and a sun hat, as they will be working outside. All children will need to bring a snack to school as usual, a packed lunch (if your child has school dinners please book a packed lunch option for this day) and a suitable drink (not fizzy) in a named disposable bag. As the children will need to carry their possessions at all times, please could they bring a named rucksack/school bag that can be carried over their shoulders.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please let their teacher know in advance. If they take travel sickness tablets then this medication needs to be handed to your child's teacher on the morning in a named envelope with instructions of how and when to take.

We kindly ask for a voluntary contribution of £12 per child to cover the cost of the visit. This needs to be paid through your PMX account under the shop items tab within the payments section. We also request that you give permission for your child to go on this trip through your PMX account, again this can be selected when clicking on the Stoke Bruerne trip item within the shop. Without your permission we will be unable to take your child on this trip. Please can all contributions and consents be made by **Friday 4th May.**
